

BOROUGH OF YOUNGSVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 451

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF
A DEPOSIT TO THE BOROUGH OF YOUNGSVILLE TO
SECURE FUTURE PAYMENTS DUE FOR WATER SERVICE,
SEWER RENTALS AND SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Youngsville provides water service, sewer rentals and solid waste disposal to its citizens and charges appropriate fees for same; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Youngsville desires to implement a deposit system whereby users of such services deposit a sum of money to the Borough as security for the payment of such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of Youngsville as follows:

1. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, all persons who request residential or commercial water service, sewer rentals and solid waste disposal as provided by the Borough of Youngsville or its authorities, shall make written application for same through the Borough office.
2. All such persons who apply for the services set forth hereinabove, shall at the time of their application deposit with the Borough of Youngsville the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to be held by the Borough of Youngsville as a security deposit for the payment for amounts due the Borough of Youngsville for the services provided as from time to time fixed by the Borough of Youngsville. Provided, however, if the applicant demonstrates that the payment of the deposit will create a financial hardship for the applicant, the Borough manager may permit said deposit to be paid in a maximum of three (3) monthly payments.

3. A deposit shall not be required of any applicant for which a municipal lien may be filed against real property of the applicant in the event of nonpayment of charges for services provided by the Borough of Youngsville.

4. In addition to any other remedy provided by the various ordinances of the Borough of Youngsville pertaining to water service, sewer rentals and solid waste disposal, if an applicant fails to pay for services provided within twenty (20) days after the due date for payment thereof, the Borough may discontinue or disconnect such services and apply any security deposit for such services to the delinquent account. If in the event a security deposit is insufficient to cover any such delinquent account, the Borough of Youngsville may resort to further legal process for the collection of any amounts still remaining due.

5. Any person who has paid a deposit in accordance with this ordinance and who gives notice to the Borough in writing of their desire to discontinue water service, sewer rentals and solid waste disposal, shall be entitled to a refund of the deposit less any amounts due and owing the Borough for such services.

6. This Ordinance shall become effective the 18 day of May, 1983.
