

RESOLUTION 2 - 2015

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF YOUNGSVILLE, WARREN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING RATES AND FEES FOR THE BOROUGH OF YOUNGSVILLE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Youngsville has adopted a codification, consolidation, and revision of the ordinances of the Borough, and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough Council to eliminate all filing fees, permits and license fees from the Code of Ordinances and enact them instead by Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved by the Council of the Borough of Youngsville that all fees are fixed as follows:

CIRCUSES AND CARNIVALS

Permit Fee \$25

RECREATION FEES

Pavilion at Island Park

Reservation Fee \$45

Reservation Deposit \$15

Pavilion at Hilltop Park

Reservation Fee \$45

With Pool Privileges \$75

Reservation Deposit \$15

RETURNED CHECK FEE \$25 plus bank fee

SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT FEES

Per schedule of Sewer Enforcement Officer, updated annually.

SEWAGE SYSTEM

Sewage System Connection \$300

Sewer Usage Per Quarter

Rate shall be based upon the quantity of water used on or in the property or premises as measured by the water meter in use on said premises. Property or premises that do not have metered water will be assessed the minimum quarterly fee for a household.

First 9,500 Gallons of Usage \$102.50
Cost per gallon over first 9,500 .0055

MINIMUM RATE is \$102.50 per quarter.

SOLID WASTE

Commercial Rates per quarter

Bags, 1x/weekly \$67 \$135
(2 - 4 Bags) (5 - 10 Bags)

Business w/Residential \$116 \$181

Special Rates per quarter

Churches \$51

Residential Rates per quarter

Family \$63
Single Person \$44
Senior Citizens (couple or single) \$44

A senior citizen is defined to be someone age sixty-two (62) or older, and a senior couple is defined to be a household wherein one of the heads of household is age sixty-two (62) or older. Senior Citizen rate does not apply if other than the senior citizen or senior couple lives in the household.

Extra cans/bags will be charged at the rate of \$1.50 per can/bag and added to the regular bill. Items not handled during the regular garbage pick-up will be treated as a special pick-up at the rate set by the following schedule or according to weight.

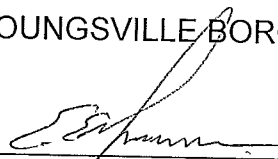

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PAYMENT FOR BOROUGH SERVICES (WATER/SEWER/SOLID WASTE) is due upon or before the 15th day of the month following the date of issuance of the billing statements. Statements unpaid after the 15th day of the month following date of issuance shall be subject to a late charge in the amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount due. Accounts unpaid after the expiration of the 30th day of the month following the issuance of the account statement shall be subject to service cancellation by the Borough in accordance with its applicable Ordinances and Regulations.

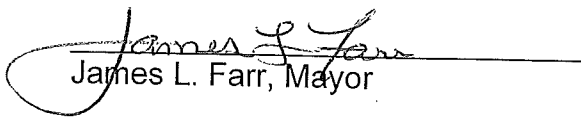
THE FOREGOING FEE SCHEDULE becomes effective on and after January 12, 2015.

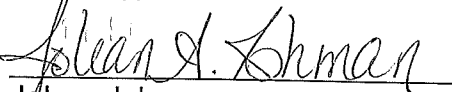
